Sammy Brauer is currently a student in the Choral Conducting program here at ASU pursuing her DMA degree. She holds a Bachelor of Music degree in Vocal Performance from Grand Canyon University, where she studied with Dr. Earl Logan. She has also completed a Master's degree in Vocal Performance and Pedagogy from ASU with Dr. Jerry Doan. Presently, she serves on the faculty of the School of Music at Scottsdale Community College, conducts the Scottsdale Master Chorale, and directs the Fine Arts program at Pleasantview Christian Academy in Phoenix. She also enjoys teaching voice in her own private studio.

Cory Evans is originally from Salt Lake City, Utah. As a choral conductor, he has served as the director of Zion's Youth Choir of Florida and as head of choral activities at Indian Hills Middle School in Sandy, Utah. He is presently the director of the Arizona Mormon Choir. As a soloist, he has performed with the Vancouver Symphony and Utah Chamber Orchestra; has been a featured member of Musica Reservata, an early period performance group; and appears on the CD "Sing Me to Heaven," released on Integra Classics. More recently, he has soloed in Schubert's Mass in G with the Gainesville Civic Chorus and at the New Texas Festival in Austin. He received a Bachelor's degree in Music Education from Utah State University and a Master's degree in Vocal Performance from the University of Florida. Cory is currently working on a DMA degree in Choral Conducting here at ASU.

Pattye Casarow is currently finishing the coursework for the DMA in Choral Conducting as well as serving as a Teaching Assistant in the Choral Department. She graduated from Grand Canyon University in 1989 with a degree in Music Education with proficiencies in voice and piano and K-12 state certification. She completed her Masters in Choral Music Education at ASU in 1997. Mrs. Casarow has taught K-12 music and choir in Georgia, New Jersey, and for the past 11 years at Mission Christian School in central Phoenix. This summer she completed her Kodály Certification. Active in church music, she has served as pianist for 19 years. Mrs. Casarow resides in Avondale with her husband, Steve, and four children.
