Born and raised in Salt Lake City, Kira is an accomplished soprano. She has sung with the Utah Opera Company and has been the soprano soloist for the ASU Choral Union on several occasions. She is currently a faculty member at New School for the Arts in Scottsdale where she teaches choir and musical theater. Mrs. Rugen continues to study voice with Claudia Kennedy in Phoenix as well as teaches privately. She is currently finishing her Masters Degree in Choral Education with an emphasis in vocal performance.

Michael Huff was born in Paris, France to a military family and began learning to play the piano just after he turned three years old. While a teenager, he studied piano at Hochschule fur musik in Frankfurt, Germany. He attended the University of Utah where he obtained a bachelor's degree in Instrumental Music Education. In 1992 he was appointed associate conductor and accompanist for the Utah Symphony Chorus. He is also artistic director of the National Invitational Band and Orchestra Festival held each spring in Dallas, New York City, Chicago, and Salt Lake City. He is pursuing the DMA in Choral Conducting and conducts Men's Chorus. Michael and his wife, Susan, are the parents of five children. They presently reside in Mesa, AZ.
