Professor Buck has worked with conductors Christoph Eschenbach, Jahja Ling, Lorin Maazel and Kurt Masur.

Prior to joining the faculty at Arizona State University, Ms. Buck was Associate Professor of Viola and Assistant Chair of the Department of Music Performance Studies at Bowling Green State University. Additionally, she spent numerous summers teaching and performing at the Pennsylvania Governor's School for the Arts. Professor Buck has presented master classes throughout North America and is an active member of the American Viola Society and the American String Teachers Association.
