Castile's murder affected me deeply; it filled me with a sense of rage and sadness. The composing process was very cathartic for me and helped me to clarify my feelings about the horrible incident

Notes by the composer:

I wanted to create an ominous atmosphere of general foreboding in the exposition and the recapitulation – this is marked by the nervous and agitated piano pattern which accompanies a portentous violin melody that soars above. The middle section is not a "development" per se, but rather, a literal musical description of Castile's killing and a lament reflecting the sadness of his losing his life. The recapitulation restates the baleful mood of the exposition, as though to say "this can happen again."
