I am very definitely in the army now so thought I would write & let you know. I was inducted the first of June but put off writing in the hope that I would get settled first. I still am not settled but thought I would write anyhow. I am subject to call any time for assignment to a unit permanently.

I have no idea where I will be sent but I only hope it will be somewhere where it is cool. The heat has been terrible here - I suppose it has been bad in St. Louis too.

I suppose you are busy getting ready for Woods Hole. I wish I were going to attend this summer but guess I will have to wait until after the war.

So far army life hasn't been at all bad - they worked me pretty hard today but I rather liked it. The only thing that bothers me are the heat and the Corporals.
