Dear Mr. Wenger:

It is a pleasure to inform you that on the recommendation of the Board of Graduate Studies you are awarded a Heermans Fellowship for the academic year 1948-49, at a stipend of \$800.

The annual stipend is on a nine months basis, and will be paid as follows: one-half month's stipend on September 30; eight equal monthly payments; one-half month's stipend on Commencement day.

This award is made with the understanding that you will be able to meet all the requirements for registration in the School of Graduate Studies in the fall of 1948. It may be withdrawn for the second semester for failure to maintain the academic standing required by the Board of Graduate Studies or at any time for reasons satisfactory to the University.

You are expected to register for and complete a full year of work as prescribed by the head of the Department in which you take your major subject, and as approved by the Board of Graduate Studies.

Will you please forward your formal acceptance not later than April 15.
