Brazilian pianist, received an Architecture degree and subsequently graduated from Magda Tagliaferro Piano School in São Paulo. He later took further instruction from Tagliaferro in Paris with a French scholarship. He has produced and directed Festivals and Musical Series in Brazil. He is also the Artistic Director of Magda Tagliaferro Foundation, where he coordinates musical editorial and phonographic projects.

He started his concert career in 1977, performing the Brazilian first performance of Stravinski's Piano Concerto as a prize-winner of the São Paulo State Competition.

Caramuru plays regularly in the most important concert halls of his country. He has recorded for Radio and TV in São Paulo, and has been recently devoting himself to research and making Brazilian music known.

In 1997 he recorded "Tom Jobim piano solo", receiving great acclaim.
